**THE LATE
Mr. E. J. Hurlstone
OF ECCLESHALL.**

It is with deep regret that we have to record the death of Mr. E. J. Hurlstone of Eccleshall which occurred on the 28th inst. at the age of 77 years.

He had been prominent in the business life of Eccleshall for a great many years during which time he had built up a Printers and Stationers business with an established connection throughout the district and the surrounding towns.

He was one of the Founders of the Eccleshall Traders' Association of which he was Chairman until a few years ago when ill health compelled him to give up the office. In 1923 he produced under the auspices of the Association the first copy of the "Eccleshall Reminder" and he has been printer and editor since its inception.

During the Great War, 1914-18, he gave a great deal of time to Recruiting and placed part of his house at the disposal of the Authorities as a recruiting office.

A few years ago he suffered a great sorrow in the untimely death of his eldest son John and he never really seemed to quit recover from the shock.

Mr. Hurlstone's kindly disposition endeared him to all who knew him and his sound and friendly advice and help was frequently sought and as freely given.

He will be greatly missed by a host of friends and the Deepest Sympathy of everyone in Eccleshall and district will be extended to his widow and family in their loss.
